- SAP PP is designed to handle:
- Material Requirement Planning (MRP): Ensures raw materials are available when needed.
- • Bill of Materials (BOM): Lists components required to produce a product.
- Work Centers & Routings: Defines where and how production operations are performed.
- Production Orders: Manages the actual execution of manufacturing tasks.
- Capacity Planning: Aligns production schedules with available resources.
- It integrates tightly with other modules like SAP MM (Materials Management), SD (Sales & Distribution), CO (Controlling), and QM (Quality Management).


